

## CALL FOR OFFICERS FY 2022-23:

Attention VAMLIS Members,

This is an open call to anyone interested in running for an officer position on the VAMLIS Executive Board. VAMLIS is a non-profit, volunteer organization with the purpose of promoting mapping and geospatial sciences in Virginia. Elections are held at the annual Virginia GIS Conference and are determined by simple ballot vote sent out to current VAMLIS members.

**The following positions will be open for FY2022-23\*: President-Elect, Vice-President, Treasurer**

*\*Terms run from July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023. Read more about each position in our [VAMLIS ByLaws](#)*

The President role is filled by the previous year's President-Elect. The Past-President roll is assumed by the most recent President in the year following his or her term. Therefore, the President-Elect position is a 3-year commitment. All other positions are eligible for re-election. The Treasurer is a 2-year term, alternating election cycles with the 2-year Secretary term. The Vice-President is a one-year term.

*Note: the President-Elect position oversees the planning committee for the annual Virginia GIS Conference, so this is a great way to bring GeoCon2023 to your area!*

The Executive Council has appointed a Nominating Committee and will hold elections at the annual conference on March 29-30, 2022. The sole responsibility of this committee is to select at least one member in good standing from the pool of voting members for each open Executive Council position. This year's Nominating Committee will be made up of the following VAMLIS members:
