



CALL FOR OFFICERS - FY 2024-2025:

Attention VAMLIS Members,

This is an open call for officer positions for the Virginia Association for Mapping and Land Information Systems (VAMLIS) Executive Board.

VAMLIS is a non-profit, professional association in Virginia designed to provide educational and networking opportunities for professionals who have an interest in the mapping sciences in Virginia. Members volunteer on committees and the Executive Board to help promote mapping and geospatial sciences in Virginia, as well as host the annual GeoCon conference. Elections are held at an annual meeting, and determined by simple ballot vote sent out to current VAMLIS members. This year, a virtual spring meeting will be held on **May 24th, 2024**, to provide VAMLIS updates, present the new nominees and commence voting.

The following positions will be open for FY2024-25*: President-Elect, Vice-President, Treasurer

The term runs from July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025 for President-Elect and Vice-President, and July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2026 for the Treasurer position. For information on the position roles, refer to the VAMLIS ByLaws. The President role is filled by the previous year's President-Elect. The Past-President role is assumed by the most recent President in the year following his or her term. Therefore, the President-Elect position is a 3-year commitment. All other positions are eligible for re-election. The Treasurer is a 2-year term, alternating election cycles with the 2-year Secretary term. The Vice-President is a one-year term.

The Executive Council has appointed a Nominating Committee and will open elections at the VAMLIS Spring Meeting. Voting will be held online. The sole responsibility of the nominating committee is to select at least one member in good standing from the pool of voting members for each open Executive Council position.
